Jozo Serdarević, M.A. has been the head of Unesco's workshop since 1994. His work motivated many students of Dubrovnik grammar school, who used their spare time to work on cultural heritage preservation projects. Their works were recognized by numerous prizes like the Prize of the Town of Dubrovnik for 1997 for exceptional accomplishments in the framework of Unesco's international project "Young people's participation in world heritage promotion and preservation".
